Commissioner Hoholik was also meeting with Steve Videtich and an electrical contractor to look at the motors on the Carpenter Dam on Thursday, April 12, 2024. Commissioner Craig Reiter reported that the McDonald Lake residents would like an agreement between the Township & County for continued use of the property by the dam for fishing and recreation. Attorney Amanda Knutson reported that Manistique Lake Authority is working on having Schoolcraft County removed from the dam. There were questions regarding whether the County would be responsible for that inspection this year.

Dr. Kristina Hansen, Superintendent of Manistique Area Schools, spoke to the Board about her new role as Superintendent. Her presentation contained upcoming events including a Fentanyl Awareness Event on Tuesday, April 16th at 6 pm at the High School Auditorium and a MCAN Job fair on April 23rd. She thanked the Board for their collaboration with MHS involving the School Resource Officer.

It was moved by Commissioner Bruce Birr and seconded by Commissioner Dan Hoholik to approve the chair to sign the letter of intent for the Multi-County Materials Management Plan. The motion carried by a unanimous aye vote of Board members present.
