WHEREAS, the County has the capacity and expertise to provide such services through	
its planning and zoning department; and	
WHEREAS, the Township and County are authorized under Public Act35 of 1951 to	
enter into intergovernmental agreements for the provision of services;	
NOW, THEREFORE, the parties agree as follows:	
1. The County shall provide zoning and planning services to the Township, including	
but not limited to:	
a. Zoning administration and enforcement;	
b. Review of zoning applications and site plans;	
c. Regulation and enforcement of short-term rental provisions.	Commented [2]: Remove for Seney Twp
2. The Township shall pay the County for services rendered under this Letter of	
Understanding in accordance with the County's adopted fee schedule for zoning	
and planning services, attached as Exhibit A, as may be amended from time to time.	
3. The County shall invoice the Township on a monthly basis, and the Township shall	
render payment within 30 days of receipt of the invoice.	
4. This County shall continue to provide the services rendered under this Letter of	

Understanding unless terminated by either party upon 30 days written notice. The

Township shall remain responsible for payment of all services rendered prior to termination.

5. This Letter of Understanding may be amended in writing by mutual consent of the parties.


