

PROTOCOL & PROCEDURE ON FORECLOSED PROPERTY

Once a property has been foreclosed on the following will happen:

- 1) The State of Michigan has 1st right of refusal on the purchase of the property.

- 2) The municipality (City, Township) in which that property is located has 2nd right of refusal on the purchase of the property. The municipality can only purchase the property if it will be for public use.

- 3) Those properties that do not get purchased by any of the above entities would then go to a public land auction.
